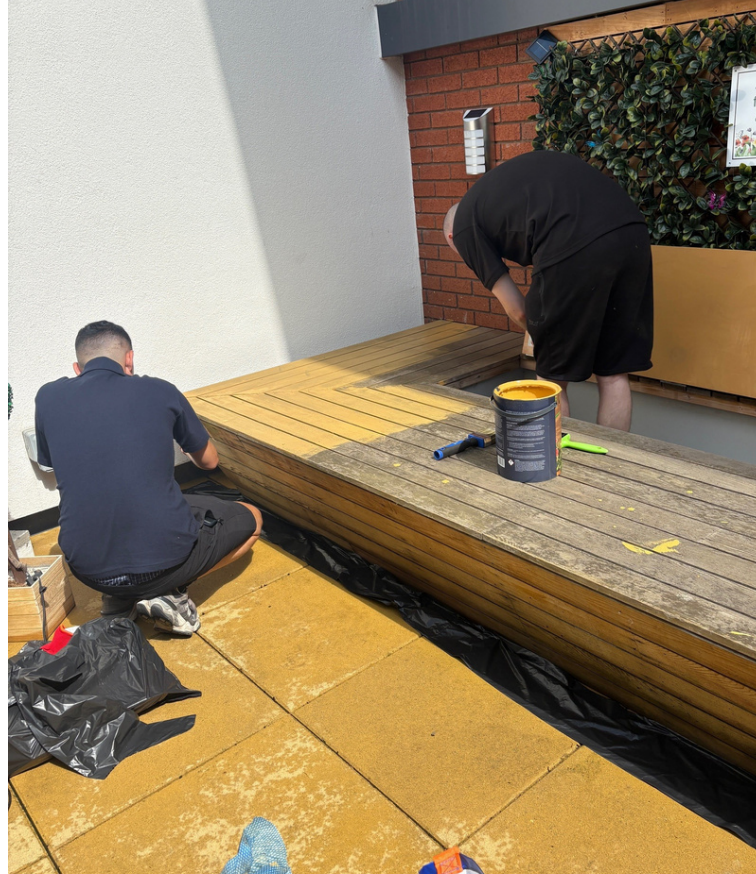
The Opportunity

Just minutes from our Grove Street regeneration project sits Liverpool Women's Hospital, a place that supports thousands of women, babies and families every year. Alongside clinical care, the hospital provides practical and emotional support to families spending extended periods within hospital accommodation, those accessing specialist treatment and those experiencing baby loss.

Rather than limiting our impact to the construction site, we chose to invest in the wider community, bringing together M&Y colleagues, suppliers and partners to support the hospital in practical, meaningful ways.

OUR CONTRIBUTION

Liverpool Women's Hospital supports between 60 and 80 families per year by providing free accommodation, helping parents stay close to their babies during treatment.

What began with a donation evolved into a wider partnership centred around practical support and community impact.

M&Y donated £6,000 to support families with babies receiving care in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit (NICU), helping provide food and essential support during extended hospital stays.

The team also delivered several improvement projects and volunteering initiatives, including:

- Refurbishment of a kitchen within family accommodation used by parents staying close to loved ones receiving treatment.
- Landscaping and improvements to outdoor spaces used by families and hospital staff.
- Improvements to garden areas supporting women and families affected by baby loss.
- Participation in fundraising events supporting the charity's wider work.

Alongside refurbishment projects and financial support, M&Y colleagues also volunteered their time preparing wellbeing packs for women undergoing treatment and new mothers accessing support services.

While small in scale, these activities reflected the wider partnership's focus on practical support, compassion and community impact.
